



Notice to Competitors #1 2023 PHRF Racing

This information is provided in accordance with section 3.1 and 4.1 of the Sailing Instructions.

Reasons for changes:

- a. Due to the low number of entries in the Flying Sails fleets, it has been decided to combine the FS and NFS entries in each of the PHRF1 and PHRF2 classes for Series 2, 3 and 4, and Medium Distance races.
- b. The small boat fleet is much larger than the big boat fleet so to better balance the fleets, the upper limit for NFS has been changed from 190 to 195.
- c. In Series 1, the PHRF2 courses were being sailed well short of target time so the course lengths have been adjusted.

The following changes are made to the NoR and SI as a result:

NoR 4.4 is replaced with

4.4 Classes are defined as follows:

<i>PHRF1</i>	<i>PHRF-LO FS-ASP < 150 PHRF-LO NFS-ASP < 195</i>
<i>PHRF2</i>	<i>PHRF-LO FS-ASP >= 150 PHRF-LO NFS ASP >= 195</i>

The splits may be adjusted by the Race Committee between Series.

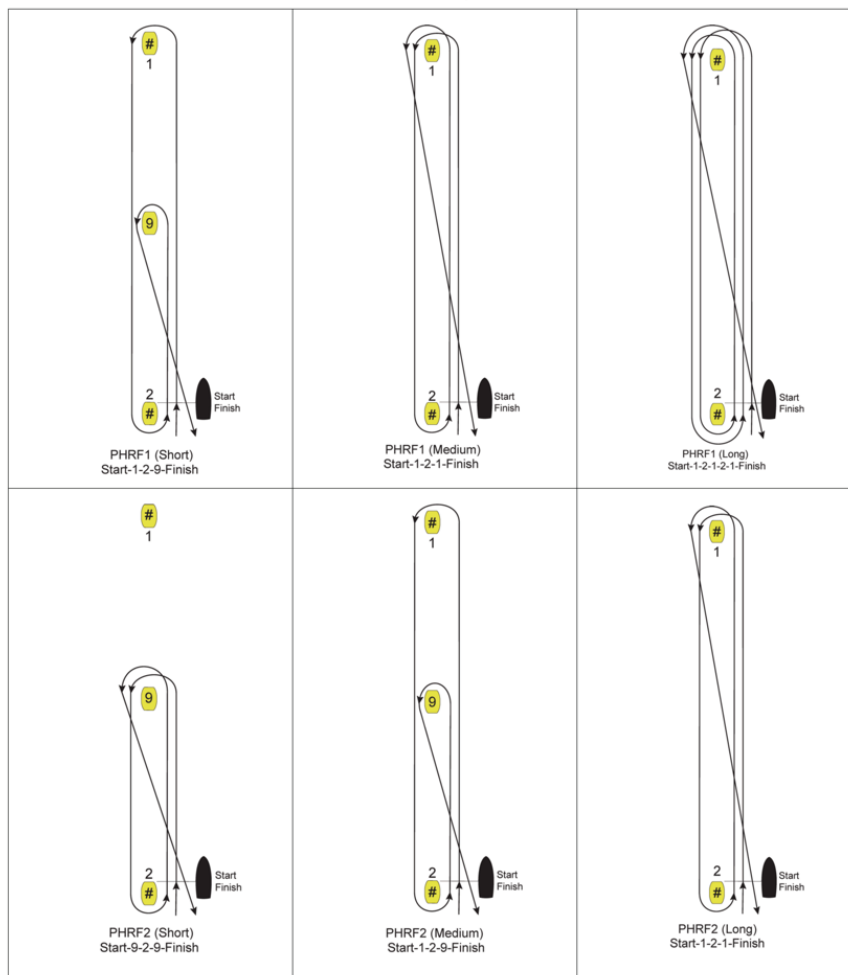
