Fleet Course Racing

Bravo Course Configuration and Target Time

This information is provided in accordance with section 2.1 and 3.1 of the Sailing Instructions.

Section 7.2 and Attachment B (see attached) are modified to place the Start/Finish line below the leeward mark and to shorten the target time to 35 minutes.

- 7.2. Bravo Course (Set Marks) is in the same area as the Alpha Course. The leeward mark will be any one of the 9 fixed marks on the Alpha Course and will be determined by the Race Committee no later than 5 minutes before the first warning. The windward mark will be set between 0.5 and 1.5 nm to windward.

These changes are made to better align the Start/ Finish line with the course and to shorten the start-to-last-finisher time so that 2 races can be run in the time available.

Attachment B – BRAVO COURSE

B1. RACING AREA

- B1.1. The race area is a circle with a diameter of 3 nm centered on fixed mark #9, which is approximately 1.4 nm on a compass bearing of 210 degrees (right) from the Whitby Harbour East Pier Head light.
- B1.2. The leeward mark (Mark 2) shall be any one the nine fixed marks on Alpha Course.

B2. COURSES

- B2.1. The course will be 2-loops of a windward-leeward course as shown below.
- B2.2. The length of the windward leg will be set such that the majority of the class will finish in 35 minutes. Two races will be run each night.

B3. MARKS

- B3.1. The Start / Finish mark will be a pin approximately 6 feet in height having an orange flag.
- B3.2. Mark 1 will be a yellow tetrahedron. The change mark will be an orange tetrahedron.
- B3.3. Mark 2 will be a barrel approximately 4 feet in height with black mark numbers on three sides. The odd numbered marks are yellow and the even numbered marks are orange.
